### United Services Lodge No. 10010 Consecration



The latest addition to the Provincial Craft Lodges is the United Services Lodge No 10010 which was Consecrated on the 14<sup>th</sup> April 2022 at the Sports and Community Centre, Wisbech St Mary and attended by a total of 136 participants and visitors. The Consecration proved to be an outstanding event with 29 of the 31 Founders attending the faultless Consecration ceremony lead by the Provincial Grand Master RW Bro. William Charles Mason Dastur.

The first Master of the Lodge, W. Bro. A.K. Mason was Installed with equal professionalism by the Deputy Provincial Grand Master VW Bro. P.B. Kilby after which the meeting concluded in routine with propositions for 3 new initiates and the promise of many joining members.

Particularly noteworthy are the Alms collection of £724 towards the Festival 2023 and the Raffle total of £765 which will be going to The MCF Ukraine Appeal.

The United Services Lodge membership is exclusive to those who have served the Sovereign, full or part time in HM Armed Forces, HM Reserve Forces, Police Service, Fire Service, Ambulance Service, Prison Service and Adults of Cadet Forces.

The Lodge will parade for regular meetings on the 4<sup>th</sup> Monday in September (Installation) and the 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday in November, February, and April at the Masonic Hall Newmarket.
